We would need confirmation and money by the April meeting - no exceptions.

We are also in contact with a bus ambassador, Kathy Limpic, with the kcrqf. If we book our visit through her, we could get a bus ambassadors package which would include: a ticket into the show at \$10.00 each prepaid and free show books for all attendees. Someone would meet the bus and give us this package, we would unload at the lower level, and be able to go up an elevator to enter into the show with tickets in hand. (If we would not do this 'package', tickets would be \$17.50 at the door this year, books would cost us, as well.)
