# MEETING MINUTES AND TREASURER'S REPORT

The regular meeting of the Blue Valley Quilt Guild was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

President Diane Swartzlander opened the meeting, with three guests present. May birthdays were recognized.

The program "Button Maze" was presented by Linda Riesberg. Members were given colored tabs with a specific button glued to the tab & were seated at three, color-related tables, with bowls of buttons (members added their cup of buttons to the mix). Participants were given one minute to find their specific button match (from the colored tab) in the bowl, after which stuffed button bears were award to one participant at each table. Ouilts embellished with buttons were displayed. After the program, attendees each received a cup of all mixed buttons to add to their stash.

#### Old Business:

It was moved and seconded that the minutes from the April, 2019 meeting be approved as printed. The motion passed.

The next Sew-Day is Saturday, June 22, 2019.

The July 4, 2019 speaker will be member Sheila Beins, who will present a program on her journey through quilting. Two presentations will be given, one at 11:00 a.m. and one at 1:00 p.m., in the upstairs of Cattle Bank. Sheila will need two quilt holders for each presentation. A possible quilt show of the late Marian Fosler is being discussed at the same location.

Quilt Nebraska is scheduled to be held in Seward at Concordia University, July 25 - 28, 2019. The first round of registrations has been completed. to 5 p.m. and Saturday, July 27, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. (may be closed during the lunch hours from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.). All members were urged to attend the event.

#### New Business:

Dorothy Heidemann-Nelson reported that the State Fair website has undergone changes, but the fair entry book is now available on the updated website (https://www.statefair.org, Competitions, Competitive Exhibits, Quilts). All entries must be submitted by due dates as stated in the regulations. Dorothy presented some of the changes to guilt entry for the 2019 Nebraska State Fair. These changes include: New leadership/sponsorship for premiums (private sponsorship this year by Bath Planet, instead of guild sponsorship); limits on number of quilts allowed to be entered; premiums for each class will be 1st-\$25.00; 2nd—\$15.00; 3rd—\$10.00; competitive classes number 72, with special classes at 23; the presentation of special ribbons is gone, with new 150th State Fair ribbons for 2019; no dropoff and return process will exist at specific locations, due to liability issues, but quilts can still be carpooled to get items to the fair; a release time of 6:00 p.m. on fair closing night has been established, also with nextmorning pickup. For more specifics on entry/participation, please view the entry book online.

Show and Share was presented, with the next meeting of the BVQG scheduled for Monday, June 17, 2019.
