
Diamond Blocks

Need: 40 - 4 inch blocks of Background Fabric

40 - 4 inch blocks of Fabric B 80 - 1 1/2 inch blocks of Fabric C


Make 80 half square triangle (HST) blocks using the 40 blocks of background fabric and Fabric B. Draw a line diagonal across Background Fabric block. Match 1 block of each right sides together.

Sew 1/4 inch on either side of line. Cut block in half on drawn line. If necessary, trim blocks to 3 1/2 inches.





After squaring HST blocks, use the 1 1/2 inch Fabric C squares to snowball the Fabric B corner. Lay the Fabric C square right sides together on Fabric B corner. Sew diagonally across the Fabric C block. Trim 1/4 inch from stiching line. Press Fabric C corner away from Fabric B to make corner





Sew 4 of these blocks together with the Fabric C points together to form a diamond block. Make 20 - 6 1/2 inch blocks
